Traffic Modifications for the William Donald Schaefer **Memorial Services**

The Baltimore City Department of Transportation would like to advise motorists of the traffic modifications and parking restrictions in effect next week during the funeral services for former Maryland Governor and Baltimore Mayor William Donald Schaefer. On Monday, **April 25, 2011** former Mayor William Donald Schaefer will lie in state at the State House in Annapolis from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Later that day, a procession for William Donald Schaefer will travel through Baltimore to some of Mr. Schaefer's favorite destinations, including the Inner Harbor and Oriole Park at Camden Yards. His body will then be brought to City Hall where he will lie in state from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. He will continue to lie in state on **Tuesday, April 26, 2011** from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Funeral services will be held for William Donald Schaefer on **Wednesday, April 27, 2011** at Old Saint Paul's Church on North Charles Street beginning at 11:00 a.m.

In preparation for these events, the following roads will be **closed on Monday, April 25, 2011 with parking restrictions in effect:**

- Saratoga Street between Gay and Holliday Streets from 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.
- Lexington Street between Guilford Avenue and Gay Street from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.
- Holliday Street from Saratoga to Lexington Streets from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

In preparation for the funeral service on **Wednesday, April 27, 2011 the following streets will be closed with parking restrictions in effect:**

- Fayette Street between Gay and N. Charles Streets from 10:15 a.m. – 10:45 a.m.
- N. Charles Street between Fayette and Mulberry Streets from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
- Saratoga Street between Liberty and Charles Streets from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Please note that area **garages located in the vicinity of the road closures listed above will be affected by the funeral service** on Wednesday morning. Patrons who utilize these garages will have access to park until 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, April 27, 2011. Then from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m., only controlled access to these garages will be allowed for those who are attending the funeral service. Patrons will be able to exit the garages at any time.

Motorists should also be aware that during times of movement for both the final tour of the city and the funeral service, there will be temporary road closures along the procession routes. Temporary delays should be expected during these times. **Citizens who do not have to travel on Monday in the vicinity of the final tour of the city or on Wednesday during the funeral service are strongly encouraged to avoid these areas.**
