Between the dates of 10/21/13 and 11/13/13, Detective Battaglia #4870, Detective Mickle #4299 and other members of the Baltimore County Police Department Robbery unit investigated a series of armed robberies throughout Baltimore County. In each of these robberies, the suspects were described as two black males, 18-30 years old, approximately 5'8" to 5'10" tall, with a thin build. In each of these incidents, the suspects entered the location armed with knives and approached employees working the register area. The suspects threatened the employees with the knives and ordered them to open the registers. In fear for their lives, the victims complied and gave the suspects money from the registers. In each of these incidents the suspects are wearing similar clothing and in several of the incidents a similar suspect vehicle is observed. The following is a synopsis of several of these incidents:

On 11/02/13 two black male suspects armed with knives entered the Dunkin Donuts located at 8021 Liberty Rd and threatened the clerk, ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~. One of the suspects pointed a knife at Mr. ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ and demanded that he open the register. The suspects fled with \$200.00. The suspects were wearing the following clothing:

2-red winter jacket with white stripe on back and shoulders, jeans, white shoes with black area around the laces

Detectives reviewed video surveillance from businesses in the area and were able to observe the suspects flee eastbound on Liberty Rd. Once in front of the Dollar Mart located at 8011 Liberty Rd, the suspects entered a white four door vehicle parked in front of the business. It should be noted that this location is several businesses away from the Dunkin Donuts. The vehicle was being operated by a third unknown subject. The vehicle then left the area. From viewing the video surveillance, detectives believed the vehicle to be a newer model Mitsubishi Galant.

On 11/05/13 two black male suspects armed with knives entered the Dollar Tree located at 817 Taylor Ave and threatened the clerk, [REDACTED]. One of the suspects placed a knife to [REDACTED] side and stated "Give me the money". [REDACTED] opened the register and the suspects fled with \$590.00. The suspects were wearing the following clothing:

Detectives were able to view video surveillance from the location. The suspects were first observed walking to the rear of the shopping center towards the Dollar Tree. It appears as if the suspects came from the Goucher Blvd area. The suspects then turn around and walk away from the Dollar Tree towards the front of the shopping center. The suspects then walk along the front of the shopping center towards the Dollar Tree. At the same time a white four door vehicle that appears to be a Mitsubishi Galant enters the parking lot in the rear of the shopping center in the same area where the suspects were first seen. The vehicle pulls around to the front and drives along the front of the shopping center. The vehicle then pulls onto the side of the shopping center out of camera view. A short time later the suspects come running out of the Dollar Tree and run directly towards the area where the vehicle was parked. The vehicle can then be seen traveling across the front parking lot and exiting.

Detectives also viewed video surveillance from the America's Best Wings which is located in the shopping center. An unknown black male subject can be seen entering the store after coming from the area where the vehicle had been parked. The subject placed an order for some food and then walked back outside and stood in front of the store. The subject then stood in front of the store for several moments before going back to the area where the car was parked. Several moments later the suspects can be seen running across the parking lot to where the vehicle had been parked. One of the suspects can be seen dropping a bandana that was later recovered by police. Employees at the America's Best Wings advised that the subject had paid for his food but had never picked it up. Based on the timing and location of the vehicle detectives believed this subject to be the driver of the vehicle.

On 11/09/13 two black male suspects armed with knives entered the Dollar Tree located at 1737 Chesaco Ave and threatened the employee, [REDACTED]. The suspects demanded that she open the register. [REDACTED] did not have the ability to open the register so another employee, [REDACTED] stepped in and

opened the register. The suspects fled with \$350.00. The suspects were wearing the following clothing:
1-gray and purple hoodie with Ravens logo, black pants, black shoes
2-gray and black striped hoodie, black jacket, black pants, white shoes with black area around laces
Detectives were able to view video surveillance from the location. At 2023 hours a vehicle that appears to be a Mitsubishi Galant can be seen entering the parking lot from Weyburn Rd. The vehicle parks at the end of the shopping center nearest to Weyburn Rd. At 2029 hours the suspects can be seen walking along the front sidewalk of the shopping center away from the area where the vehicle had parked. The suspects are never seen exiting the vehicle. The suspects then walk all the way to the other end of the shopping center and disappear from camera view for a short time. The suspects then walk down the sidewalk and stand outside of the Dollar Store for a moment before entering. The suspects run out of the Dollar Store directly to the white four door vehicle. After entering the vehicle the suspects flee on Weyburn Rd towards Chesaco Ave.

On 11-13-13 at approx 2148 hrs Baltimore County Police were dispatched to the 7-11 located at 6315 Sherwood Rd 21212. As Officer Ruby #5653 arrived he spoke to Victim [REDACTED] Victim [REDACTED] advised that she was standing outside when she was approached by two subjects later identified as the defendants Adrian James Walden and Damon Carlos Williams. As the defendants approached her they stated "hurry up in the store, open the register". She went onto say that as she entered the store defendant Walden pushed her to the cash register as defendant Williams hopped over the counter as he held a pink handled knife and began taking packs of Newport Cigarettes and began stuffing them into his pants and vest pockets and then took three big bite hot dogs. Victim [REDACTED] stated that as she stood by the register defendant Walden stated "hurry up bitch, open the register". Victim [REDACTED] stated that she felt a sharp object that had been put into her back and that she believed that it was a knife. Victim [REDACTED] advised that she opened the cash register and as she did defendant Walden began taking money from the cash register. Victim [REDACTED] believed that the amount of money that was taken from the register was approximately \$40.00 but was not sure. She stated that defendant Walden asked her if she could open the drop safe and she advised him that she could

not. Victim [REDACTED] advised that once the defendants took the items they fled across Sherwood towards the Sherwood Market. Victim [REDACTED] described defendant Walden as approx 5-5 160 lbs wearing black pants, black sweatshirt, black gloves and a knit ski mask. The victim described defendant Williams as wearing a beige colored vest, red shirt with a gray hood, blue jeans, purple bandana over his face and wearing no gloves. Victim [REDACTED] advised that she was in fear for her life during the robbery.

A look at the 7-11 video yielded the following: Defendants Walden and Williams approached victim [REDACTED] outside of the store. Defendant Williams hopped over the counter and began placing packs of cigarettes into his pockets as defendant Walden took victim [REDACTED] to the cash register. As victim [REDACTED] opened the register defendant Walden began taking money out. Both suspects then proceeded out the front door towards Sherwood Rd. The loss value of the ten packs of cigarettes was \$70.80.

A Be On The Look Out was given and a search of the area by police was conducted. At approx 2200 hrs Officers Langley #4693, Vlach #5346 and Phass

#4096 were traveling on Loch Raven Blvd near Northern Parkway when they observed a white Mitsubishi Gallant bearing Maryland registration 5AZ0973. These officers knew that a white Mitsubishi had been present during multiple robberies that had occurred in Baltimore County. The vehicle was parked facing northbound on the corner of The Alameda and Northern Pky. The vehicle quickly made a u-turn and turned left onto eastbound Northern Pky. The vehicle then left onto Loch Raven Blvd and then made a u-turn back onto southbound Loch Raven Blvd. The vehicle then stopped and picked up a subject at Loch Raven Blvd and Walker Ave. A closer look into the vehicle revealed that the passengers were wearing clothing similar to the defendants involved in the robbery at 7-11. Officer Langley then initiated an investigative traffic stop on the Mitsubishi on Loch Raven Blvd near Cold Spring Lane. As these officers approached the vehicle these officers observed numerous packs of unopened Newport cigarettes, and U.S. currency lying on the front and rear floor boards. Detective Vlach observed a black bandana lying on the rear passenger floor board. The officers had the driver identified as defendant Solomon King Dunn along with the two occupants identified as defendants Walden, seated in the front, and Williams seated in the rear passenger seat.

Officer Mims responded to the scene of the investigative stop and had defendant Walden exit the vehicle. As defendant Walden exited the vehicle he observed a pink handled knife located to the front of his pants. As Officer Mims secured the knife defendant Walden stated "that's my knife". Officer Mims also observed multiple packs of unopened Newport Cigarette boxes falling out of his pockets. A search of defendant Walden's person yielded two purple bandanas concealed in his right shirt sleeve.

A search of defendant Williams yielded a black handled fixed blade knife. Officer Langley also noticed that were the defendant had been seated there were packs of unopened Newport Cigarettes and U.S. Currency located on the floor board. Defendant Williams was also wearing the tan vest and white shoes with black around the laces seen in several of the incidents. All three defendants were detained for the Baltimore County Robbery Unit and transported to 700 E Joppa Rd to be interviewed by robbery detectives.

During a post Miranda interview with defendant Walden he confessed to his involvement in the armed robbery at the 7-Eleven. He advised that he had committed the robbery because he had no food to eat. When asked about the other incidents he stated that they were the same as the 7-Eleven. He would not provide any further information. During a post Miranda interview with defendant Williams he confessed to his involvement in all of the above listed incidents. After committing the robbery at the 7-Eleven he had become separated from defendant Walden and was unable to get back to the vehicle. He waited at the bus stop for several minutes before defendant Dunn picked him up. He advised that this was just prior to being stopped by police. He advised that defendants Walden and Dunn were responsible for planning the locations where the robberies would occur. Defendant Dunn then drove them to each location in his Mitsubishi Galant. He and defendant Walden would then go into the stores to commit the robberies.

During a post Miranda interview with defendant Dunn he advised that he was working for a sedan service. He advised that he had picked up the suspects just prior to being stopped by police and had no knowledge of any robbery. He

advised that prior to being stopped by police he had last driven the suspects on 10/31/13. Defendant Dunn was then shown video surveillance photographs showing his vehicle picking up the suspects in several incidents since 10/31/13. He then admitted to picking up the suspects in each of the incidents but claimed to have no knowledge of the robberies. He was also shown photographs of the subject from the America's Best Wings and admitted that he was the subject. He stated that the suspects texted him the address of where to pick them up. He went to the location and parked on the side of the business. It should be noted that the area where defendant Dunn parked was not a parking area and was not a location where normal customers would park. He then went inside and ordered food. The suspects came back to the car and said they were in a hurry and would pay him for the food he had ordered.

All events occurred in Baltimore County.
