It is necessary that you submit a photocopy of your new Medical Examiner's Certificate along with a completed copy of the form DL-330, "Driving Certification for Maryland Commercial Driver's License Holders" to the Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA).

The MVA must receive all requested items prior to the above expiration date completed in full. If you no longer wish to retain your Commercial Driver's License (CDL), you must visit an MVA office to downgrade your CDL to a noncommercial license. Failure to supply the required documents or downgrade your CDL will result in cancellation of your entire driving privilege.

NOTICE OF MEDICAL EXAMINER'S CERTIFICATE EXPIRATION LETTER
