NARRATIVE					
<p>1. On February 19th, 2012, at approximately 6:40pm, I [REDACTED] was alerted to a fight in the lobby at Forest Hills Station. Upon arrival I saw a man later identified as a [REDACTED] bleeding from the face and being assisted by some people. When I asked him what happened, he told me he had just been attacked by a group of girls and that they had just gone down the stairs to the lower bus way. I asked him if he thought he could point them out and he followed me down the stairs.</p> <p>2. A man that was on the steps stated to me " those girls just went across the street, up that street over there", indicating Tower Street. I went across the street and proceeded up Tower Street with [REDACTED] behind me. I called in my location to Control and advised them that I was searching for suspects to an assault. The W846, Officers [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] responded to assist me.</p> <p>3. I caught up to two females at the end Tower Street and [REDACTED] identified one of them as one of the three girls that assaulted him. The other female was present, but did not take part in the assault. The suspect, was identified as a [REDACTED]. The W846 arrived on scene and assisted me, taking a statement from the victim and his partner, a [REDACTED] while I interviewed the suspect.</p> <p>4. [REDACTED] stated that she and [REDACTED] got into a verbal altercation when he "bumped" her with his backpack. [REDACTED] states that [REDACTED] took a swing at her and she then struck him in self defense. [REDACTED] stated that after he and [REDACTED] exchanged words, she and two of the three females that were with her, jumped him and started punching and kicking him. He could not say who kicked him, but did identify [REDACTED] as initiating the attack. Afterwards, the females fled the station and [REDACTED] realized his backpack was missing.</p> <p>5. The female accompanying [REDACTED] was identified as a Ms. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated that she was the only one that did not assault him. The other two suspects were not located. [REDACTED] identified one of the other suspects as her sister, a [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] states that [REDACTED] is in Foster care and she has no further information on her.</p> <p>6. Ambulance 17, with medics; [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] arrived on scene to check [REDACTED] injuries. They transported [REDACTED] to Carney Hospital for evaluation.</p> <p>7. [REDACTED] was told that she would be summons to court for the charge of Assault and Battery. She and [REDACTED] were then released. [REDACTED] stated he wanted to press charges and [REDACTED] stated his willingness to testify.</p> <p>8. The initial incident began on the stairs coming up from the lower bus way on the route 42 side of the station. The actual assault took place in the main lobby at Forest Hills Station at approximately 6:38pm near the CSA booth and should be on camera. The video may help determine who kicked [REDACTED] and who took his bag. The W846 conducted an area search for the bag with negative results.</p>
