ORDER

Having considered the filings received and the entire record herein, and finding that Plaintiff FXP LLC has satisfied all the requirements to obtain a temporary restraining order, this court hereby orders that:

1. Defendants shall allow representatives of Plaintiff to speak during the public part of the March 27, 2012, Board of Selectmen meeting on topics relating to Defendants' interest in Plaintiff's land located in Foxborough, MA, and specifically, to speak with regard to actions of the Town of Foxborough to consider or act on proposals to take Plaintiff's land by eminent domain and to bid out rights to billboards that are located on Plaintiff's land.
2. Defendants shall not interfere with Plaintiff's rights as set forth in the preceding paragraph.
3. This Order shall apply to the Board of Selectmen meeting currently scheduled to begin at 7:00 P.M. on March 27, 2012, as well as to any postponement date or

other date on which the Board of Selectmen meet in public session to hear about, discuss, or consider matters regarding eminent domain or bidding out of rights that concern real property owned by Plaintiff in Foxborough.
