

The process of creating the 2018 Red Sox Championship Ring mirrored the achievements of the 2018 team by perfectly melding all elements to make history. Crafted in 14-karat white gold, this ring is arguably one of the richest in symbolism and storytelling ever made.

In total, the 2018 Boston Red Sox Championship ring boasts 185 stones which represent the 162 regular season games plus 14 postseason games plus the 9 World Series titles now held by the Red Sox. The ring features 4.5 carats of diamonds, 6.5 carats of blue sapphires and 4.0 carats of rubies for a total gem weight of 15 carats.


